General Supplies

- Air mattresses
- Adaptive devices
- Supply of blankets, bath towels, washcloths, 2-3 day of supply of clothing
- Pillows, and sheets
- Water (include staff and volunteers)
- Tube feedings
- Supplements
- Juices and/or Gatorade
- Styrofoam collar and ice for medications
- Emergency medication kit
- Ice chest
- Adequate food provisions
- Medications, treatment administrative records
- Flow records, census for staff and volunteers
- An additional 60 mattresses
- Personal hygiene items

- Sterile soaps
- Catheter trays/kits
- Germicidal
- G-tubes
- Sterile 4x4's
- Alcohol
- Hypoallergenic tape
- Betadine
- Medications
- Insulin syringes
- Kling
- Catheters
